YOU CAN PHRASE YOUR BEQUEST AS SUCH:

“I, (name) of (city, state, ZIP) give, devise and bequeath to Mill Neck Foundation located at 40 Frost Mill Rd. in Mill Neck, NY 11565, for their general purposes the amount of \$_____ (or _____% of the remainder and residue of property owned at my death).”

YOU CAN ALSO MAKE A CONTINGENT BEQUEST:

“If my sister Jane Doe survives me, I devise and bequeath 25% of the remainder and residue of property owned at my death to Jane Doe. If Jane Doe does not survive me, then I devise and bequeath 25% of my residuary estate to Mill Neck Foundation located at 40 Frost Mill Rd. in Mill Neck, NY.”

ABOUT US

In 1949, Lutheran Friends of the Deaf purchased “Sefton Manor”—a mansion set on 86-acres—with the vision to raise funds to begin a school for the Deaf. In 1951, the Mill Neck Manor Lutheran School opened its doors to 19 Deaf boys and girls. Today, the Mill Neck Family of Organizations is made up of the Mill Neck Manor School for the Deaf, Mill Neck Services, Center for Hearing Health, Lutheran Friends of the Deaf, Mill Neck International and the Mill Neck Foundation.

The mission of the Mill Neck Family of Organizations is to better the lives of children and adults who are Deaf, Hard of Hearing or have other disabilities through innovative educational, occupational and spiritual services.

The individuals Mill Neck serves come from all social and economic backgrounds, with the hope that one day they will have an opportunity to leave their mark on the world, just like everyone else.



HOW IT WORKS

Making a bequest is easy! Simply include verbiage in your will or trust that specifies that a gift is to be made to the Mill Neck Foundation or any other Mill Neck Organization. (See back panel for verbiage)

You can also use a beneficiary designation form to make a bequest. Your attorney, or ours, can help you with your estate plan. If you do not have an estate attorney, call Barbara Lewis, Executive Assistant, at 516-628-4226.



- Include a bequest to Mill Neck Foundation in your will or revocable trust.
- Designate Mill Neck Foundation as a full, partial or contingent beneficiary in your unused retirement account (IRA, 401(k), 403(b) or pension). Since IRAs and qualified retirement plans are reduced by income taxes when passed to loved ones other than a spouse, by naming Mill Neck Foundation as a beneficiary, you can eliminate some or all of the income taxes due.
- Designate Mill Neck Foundation as a beneficiary in your life insurance policy.

CHARITABLE BEQUEST AMOUNT

YOU CAN MAKE A BEQUEST IN SEVERAL WAYS:

- **As a percentage:** Specify what percentage of your estate you give as gift
- **Specific bequest:** Make a gift of an asset (stocks, bonds, car, boat, house, etc.) or a specific dollar amount
- **Residual bequest:** Make a donation from the balance or residue of your estate
