Rev. Timothy Yeadon currently serves as the Bishop and District President of the New England District of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. He was elected to that position by his Church Body in June of 2012. Prior to that election he served one congregation as Pastor in his entire career, beginning in 1985, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in New Hartford Connecticut. He and his wife of 32 years, Ruth, continue to live in northwest Connecticut.
