## **“Tee off Fore the Early Childhood Center” at Mill Neck Family’s “Spring Swing” Golf Tournament**

The Mill Neck Family of Organizations will hold its 6<sup>th</sup> annual “Spring Swing” on Thursday, June 14, 2012. Golfers will tee off at the North Hills Country Club in Manhasset, where the Invitational Golf Tournament will kick-off the “Restoring Hope, Building Dreams” Campaign for the Early Childhood Center (ECC). Part of the Mill Neck Family of Organizations, the ECC provides early and intensive assistance to children, ages 3 and 4, who may have deficits in speech, language/communication, cognitive and gross and fine motor development.

Founded in 1991, the Early Childhood Center is scheduled to undergo a much-needed building renovation project. The “Restoring Hope, Building Dreams” \$800,000 project seeks to improve the functionality of the ECC building, in addition to upgrading and enhancing its internal structure and appearance. Spring Swing proceeds will benefit this important project, ensuring that the hopes and dreams of preschoolers with special needs remains a reality.

The entry fee of \$350 per person includes a delicious brunch, golf challenges, refreshments and lunch on the course, cocktails and Champions Dinner. Honoree recognition, raffle prizes, silent auction and golf contest awards will take place at the evening’s dinner. Non-golfers are welcome to register for dinner only at \$100 per person. In addition to specialized services for 3 and 4 year olds with special needs, the Early Childhood Center also provides full evaluations of preschool children suspected of having developmental delays.
