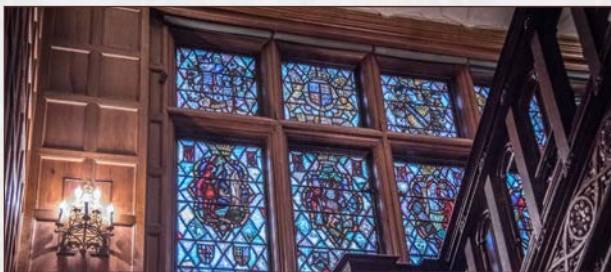


Mansion Tours at THE HISTORIC MILL NECK MANOR

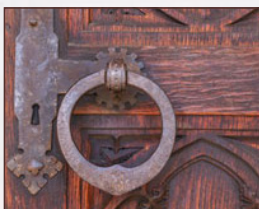
Mill Neck Manor, located on Long Island's prestigious North Shore, is a majestic Tudor Revival mansion. It is set on an 86-acre scenic estate overlooking the Long Island Sound.

The 1920s mansion, once called Sefton Manor, was the home of Robert Leftwich Dodge and his wife, cosmetics heiress Lillian Sefton Dodge.

In 1949, Lutheran Friends of the Deaf, founders of the Mill Neck Family of Organizations, purchased the property from Mrs. Dodge.
